Background	The Karana Family are one of the three great Founding Families of Tehmor, who family legend says first settled in the area in the Year 100. They are now one of the wealthiest and most powerful families in Tehmor, with many commercial interests, especially in the Red Light District. The Karanas were originally Cougar Cultists from the Grasslands and as the City grew they domesticated smaller wild cats and used them to catch rodents and as spies. The Head of the Family has long held the hereditary franchise of Chief Ratcatcher of Tehmor - which has led to centuries of conflict with the Rat Cult, who consider this to be one of their functions (the difference being that the Rat Cult simply moves					

	the Rats elsewhere, whilst the Karanas kill them or feed them to their pets). They also have a longstanding feud with the Derevo Family, the origins of which are now largely forgotten but which has been fuelled by the Karanas being a largely Good, West Side family of Cat Cultists and the Derevos being a largely Evil, East Side family of Dog Cultists. The Karanas are behind The Catalyst Gin, a Tehmor dry gin flavoured with botanicals from the edge of the Desert, which is a rival to the Derevos' spirits and is favoured by the sophisticated drinkers of the West Side and in the Red Light District. It is usually served in a cocktail with a sprig of catnip.
